

## 2010 Saugerties GIANT Flea Market – Information, Rules and Guidelines

Form 2010-2

Location: Saugerties Flea Market will be held at the CVS/Grand Union Plaza, in the parking lot in front of the former Grand Union building

Dates and hours: The flea market will be held **Saturday, October 9, 2010**. 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Rain dates are always the very next day (Sunday). By signing up for this market, you are indicating that you will participate, whether the market is held on the primary date or the rain date. **Regardless of the day the event is held (Sat. or Sun.), vendors who do not show up will not have their checks returned.**

Fees/Spaces: In total, there are 46 spaces. 3 or so spaces are food vendor spaces and the others are for flea market “goods for sale” vendors. Food vendors are defined as vendors who sell food to be consumed at the event (in contrast with packaged food vendors, who are considered regular vendors.) Spaces will be numbered and assigned to selected vendors.

We have “Regular” \$40 spaces (17' x 18') and “Premium” \$50 spaces (17' x 18', with adjacent parking for your vehicle). (Food vendors get a \$15 discount from those prices, but can participate only if they have a Dept. of Health permit.) Vendors with \$40 or \$25 spaces must park behind the Grand Union building (if not, you will take parking spaces away from our customers).

Selection is on the basis of 1) the date/time your check arrives in the SACofC P.O. Box and b) the quality and variety of items being sold. Please restrict your setup area to the assigned space, and be courteous regarding leaving aisle space for other vehicles as you load/unload.

Saugerties Area Chamber of Commerce. Completed application and payment should be sent to SACofC, P.O. Box 731, Saugerties, NY 12477 to arrive no later than Friday, Oct. 1st, 2010.

We will let you know if you have been selected by Monday, Oct. 4th, 2010.

The decision of the Chamber is final. Fees submitted by selected vendors are not returnable. Fees submitted by vendors who are not selected will be returned.

If there are not at least 46 vendors requesting spaces by October 1<sup>st</sup>, the Chamber reserves the right to cancel the event. In this case, all vendors will be contacted in a timely fashion and all fees returned.

Set-up: Vendors may set up as early as 7 a.m. All set-up must be complete & (with the exception of \$50 spaces), all cars must be off the flea market area no later than 8:45 a.m. Vendors should unload and remove their vehicles before starting booth set-up. Aisles allow two lanes of vehicle traffic; please do not block 2 lanes as you unload your items. There is free parking nearby. If a vendor reserves a space and does not show up by 8:45 a.m., their space will remain unoccupied or be reallocated, but no refund is possible. Each vendor is responsible for tent/canopy\*, tables, chairs, umbrellas, etc. Neither water nor electricity are available. (Water *is* sold in nearby stores and often by vendors as well.) Vendors must ensure their tents/canopies are properly anchored with ropes and cement blocks. (Spikes cannot be driven into the parking lot surface.)

Trash: Each vendor is responsible for taking away his or her own trash. Vendors who ignore this request will not be allowed to return. Please do not use local merchants' dumpsters. Trash cans are provided.

Wares: Antiques, collectibles, handcrafted items, and arts and crafts will be given priority. The Chamber has the authority to decline any vendor whose merchandise it deems not appropriate. We will appreciate each vendor's continued efforts to make the Market attractive and an asset to Saugerties, especially nearby neighbors.

Liability: The Saugerties Area Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for any illness or injury sustained as a result of any individual vendor or customer participating in the Market.

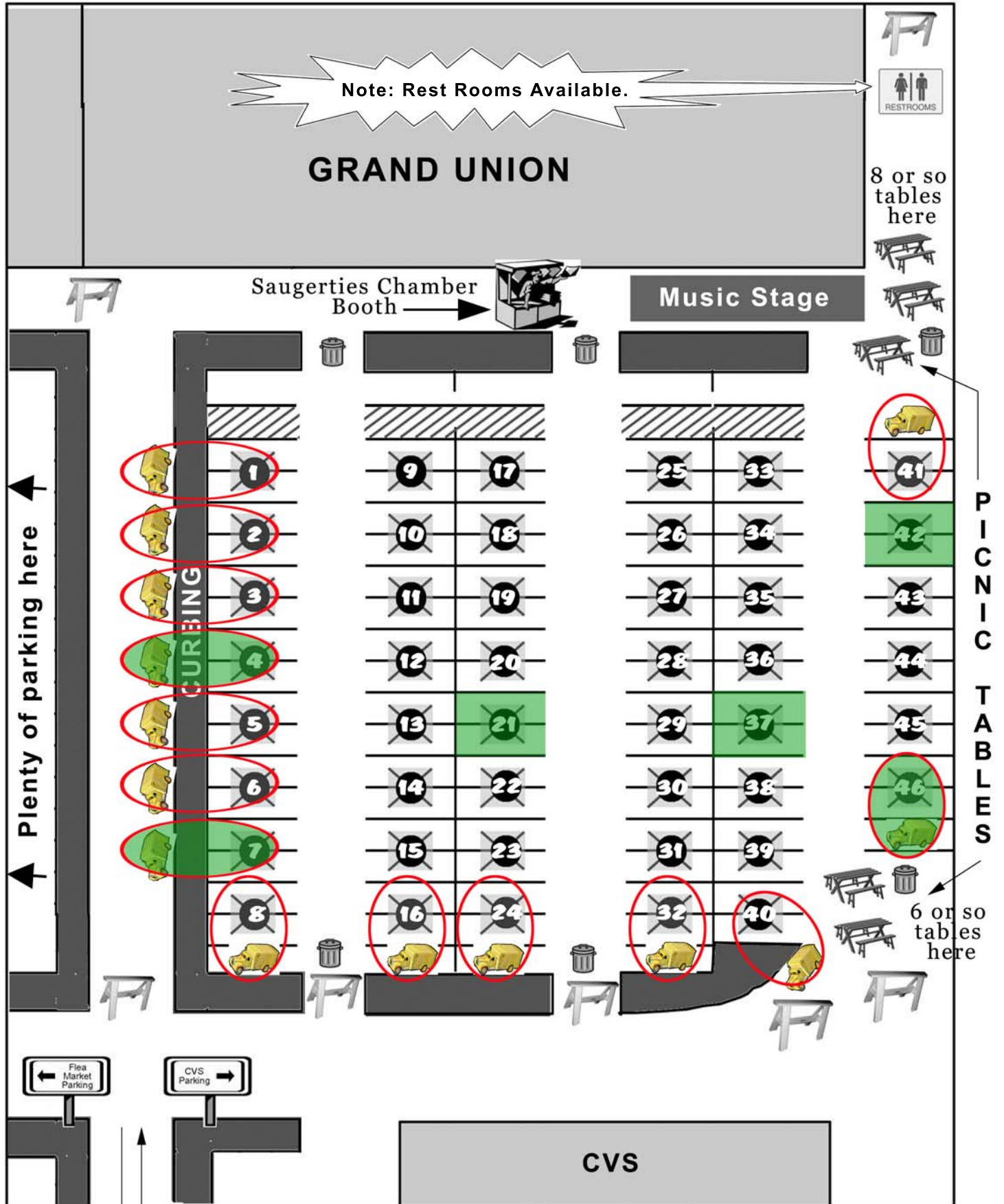
